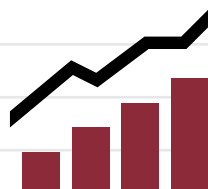
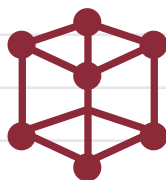
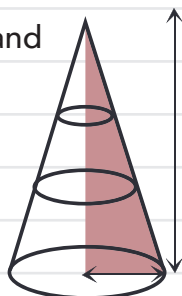

How to Enrol:

Step 1: Find the necessary forms on: www.covenantcollege.co.za

Step 2: Complete the Application for Assessment.

Step 3: Submit Forms to school, learner applicant will be contacted for an assessment. A non-refundable Assessment fee (R200) is payable on the day of the assessment.

Step 4: Once a learner is successful in their assessment; parents will receive an Enrolment Pack with all the necessary forms and agreements. A non-refundable Enrolment Fee (R400) is then payable.

Step 5: Upon receipt of all completed Enrolment Pack forms, agreements and payment of the Enrolment Fee your child's place at our school is secured.

Please Note:

To enable a learner to fully benefit from the Covenant College curriculum and environment, it is necessary to assess each application for admission. Applicants are assessed according to normal age and grade appropriate assessments and, if necessary, extra assessments or interviews may be requested.
